#### **Order of Events**

Sunday evening: Arrival Reception (make new friends!)

Monday and Tuesday: Every team plays three games (hurry hard!)

Tuesday evening: Reception, Banquet and Entertainment (fun, fun, fun!)

Wednesday morning: Finals (or maybe some village shopping if this isn't you)

There is lots more to do in your free time: X-Country ski trails, snowshoeing, skating - rental equipment

for these is easy to organize (\$), dogsledding (\$), spa treatments (\$)

#### **Bonspiel Cost (Spectacular Log Curling Club built in 1931, four sheets)**

Entry fee: \$125.00 per team (\$31.25 per curler).

**Prepayment:** Skips are responsible for submitting the team's entry form and payment directly to the hotel.

#### **Accommodation Cost**

Teams have two beautiful rooms (two beds per room). Montebello will try to make them adjoining. Cost is around \$700 per curler (incl taxes) based on Double Occupancy (3 nights).

Cost includes Arrival Reception, Three Buffet Breakfasts (Monday – Wednesday), Three Dinners, (Sunday, Monday, Tuesday Reception & Banquet), use of sports facilities, (swimming pool, hot tub, skating), and sleigh ride (depending on group size and weather)

Pre-payment: Each skip submits the hotel registration form directly to the hotel for the team and pays deposit.

#### **Bus Transportation**

Bus cost is approximately \$150 per curler (two-way).

The starting point is 75 Wynford Heights Crescent. If this is your starting point, please carpool or arrange to be dropped off. If necessary, limited underground parking is available.

Typically, other curlers are picked up in Scarborough, Napanee and Kingston (subject to change).

**Pre-payment:** Each skip submits the total bus fee with their team names to the Coordinator prior to leaving. Cost includes bus fare; driver accommodations and tips for bus driver and concierges and gourmet sandwiches for the return ride home.

#### What to Bring

**Clothes**: Curling shoes and broom, warm clothes (rink is colder than most clubs), swimsuit. Something "dressy" for the banquet - and your dancing shoes and singing voice!

**Entertaining supplies:** After each game the winning team hosts the losing team in their rooms with snacks & drinks. Each team is advised to split up the list of items to bring - sample list will be provided.

#### **Summary of Expenses (includes Bus, and Tips)**

Total cost is approximately \$880 plus cost of snacks & drinks you bring. \$730 without bus.
